

## **Complimentary Memberships for New Amateur Radio Licensees**

1. The Clark County Amateur radio club offers a complimentary (no cost) membership for those who have (1) attended a CCARC License class, and (2) passed the test at the associated CCARC VE session.
2. Candidates must fill out the form offered at the VE session requesting the membership to be eligible.
3. Of those who do the above and attend the next scheduled CCARC Ham Club meeting, their names will be put into a drawing for a 1 year membership to the ARRL. The name will be drawn at that meeting. The winner must be present to win.
4. Only those passing their very first amateur license test and who are not a current member nor have been for the past calendar year are eligible for this offer.
5. The 1 year CCARC membership timing considerations are:
  - a. If the test is passed before June 30, the membership will go through the end of the calendar year.
  - b. If the test is passed after June 30, the membership will go through the end of the next calendar year. For example the test is passed 8/15/2015, the membership is good through 12/31/2016.
6. The complimentary CCARC membership entitles the amateur "full paid" membership rights and privileges, including voting and badge, until it expires or is renewed after the complimentary period.
7. The ARRL membership is a full membership and is valid for one year. It is up to the individual to renew at the end of the 1 year period. It will not be renewed by the CCARC.
