Youth First Radio Scholarship Instructions

Application Instructions:

1. This page is not a part of the application and need not be submitted.
2. The scholarship is for a working radio to be used by a student which is commensurate with their license class. A working radio may be a new radio or a working used radio.
3. This scholarship is for a youth's first radio. This is to be interpreted by the Board as a youth's first hand held radio used with technician class privileges or a youths first HF radio with general class privileges.
4. Scholarships are awarded to students in grade school through high school levels (K-12).
5. Scholarship applications will be reviewed and granted by the CCARC Board at their regularly scheduled Board meetings.
6. When multiple applications are received, preference will be given to CCARC club members.
7. Scholarships will be award based on availability of donated equipment available to be applied to the scholarship program.
8. If the space provided for your responses is not large enough, you may write "see attached" on the application and include an enclosure or resume. Be sure the enclosure or resume is clearly marked as to the question each portion applies and includes your full name.
9. Use only one side of the application form. Please do not write on the reverse side. Attach additional sheets as necessary.
